Cyber Security Awareness Campaign-2020

- 1) CyberMitra/Applicant is willing to follow the regulatory guidelines for CyberMitra under Cyber Security Awareness Campaign by MPCON/MPCON Cyber Excellence Division (MPCED).
- 2) Cyber Mitra /Volunteer/Applicant will provide all information about the Cyber Security Awareness Campaign by MPCON, to the district associates/local associates/ school principals/coordinator/students.
- 3) CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant will not receive any cash payment from the school/students or candidate seeking registration for the Cyber Security Awareness Campaign by MPCON.
- 4) CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant will identify the minimum no of Schools in a locality as per the need and guidelines of the marketing head.
- 5) CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant will promote the Cyber Security Awareness Campaign by organizing Meetups (orientation programs) in schools for students.
- 6) CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant will coordinate with MPCON Cyber Excellence Division official and report them regarding my activities related to Cyber Security Awareness Campaign.
- 7) CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant will Monitor, control and manage the Cyber Security Awareness Campaign promotions and programs in my city.
- 8) CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant will guide and manage school coordinators to motivate students for registering in Cyber Security Awareness Campaign.
- 9) CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant will assist MPCON Cyber Excellence Division in distributing the certificates of Cyber Security Awareness Campaign.
- 10) CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant will be responsible for any local dispute, which is to be settled by me only.

- 11) CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant will not misguide the school coordinator/candidates/associates by providing false information.
- 12) CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant will work only in the authorized area.
- 13) CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant will myself be responsible for any dispute arising due to violation of rules and regulations of the MPCON Cyber Excellence Division and CLP by me.
- 14) Any dispute(s) arising out due to CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant volunteering activities or because of CyberMitra/Volunteer/Applicant then it shall be resolved amicably between both the parties (you and MPCON Cyber Excellence Division or Cyber Law Pioneer Pvt. Ltd. (CLP), failing which such dispute(s) shall be taken under court of law.
- 15) The place of jurisdiction shall be Bhopal.
