

Privacy Policy

MPCON, ("MPCON", "MPCON CYBER EXCELLENCE DIVISION" "we", "our", or "us") provides this Privacy Policy to inform you of our policies and procedures regarding the collection, use and disclosure of personal information we receive via our Service (as defined in the Terms of Service below) from users of our Service. We value the trust you place in us. That's why we insist upon the highest standards and strictly follow the provisions of the Information technology Act, Indian legal procedure and the Indian Contract Act for customer information privacy.

This is important; we hope you will take time to read it carefully. Our services connect people with the online education and examination. 1. Information Collection and Use

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, "Personal Information" means information that can be used to uniquely identify you, such as your name, telephone number, address, and e-mail address and MPCED's account access credentials.

1.1 We do not collect a "personal sensitive information" of user defined in the rule 03 of the Information Technology (Reasonable Security Practices and Procedures and Sensitive Personal Data or Information) Rules, 2011 except your password to access MPCON's account only.

1.2 Personal Information We Collect

When you interact with us, we may ask you to supply us with Personal Information. For example, we may collect Personal Information when you:

- Submit an online application form to create a MPCON's account.
